...any settler who considered himself a Congregationalist, found two opportunities for worship according to their own customs, neither of which was entirely satisfactory. There was a church in Stow, but it was not an especially strong church, so it is not surprising that most preferred the church at Tallmadge, but it was an ox-cart journey from home. The only other Congregationalist institution was a Sunday School carried on at the home of Mrs. Sophia Wetmore. In response to this, a meeting was held on December 8, 1833, "at the School House at Cuyahoga Falls to consider the Expediency of forming a [Congregationalist] Church at this place." The meeting was attended by Rev. Benson Baldwin, Elisha Sill, Henry Newberry, Birdsey Booth, Jabez Hamlin, Ogden Wetmore, Frederick Upson, and "several ladies." Apparently the meeting was a success, for on the 14th of February, 1834, the group met again and founded the First Congregational Church of Cuyahoga Falls. Actually the attendance at the second meeting was a little different—Jabez Hamlin was not present, although he did become active in the new church, but a Rev. J. C. Parmelee of Tallmadge was there. Furthermore, the "several ladies" were identified as Mrs. Elizabeth Newberry, Miss Fanny Newberry, Miss Mary Newberry, Mrs. Julia Newberry Wetmore, and Mrs. Charlotte Lawson, who had moved to Cuyahoga Falls in 1832 with her husband, William A. Lawson. The new congregation chose Rev. Baldwin as its first pastor, although he would have to alternate between First Congregational Church and the First Presbyterian Church of Middlebury, as part of Akron was known in those early days. Services were held at the Lyceum, erected on the southeast corner of Front and Broad, until the present church building was completed in 1847.

The first organizing document of the church was the Confession and Covenant, adopted at the February 14, 1834 meeting....It was on March 2, 1835, that the First Congregational Society, consisting of Birdsey Booth, Ogden Wetmore, Henry Newberry, and ten other men, was incorporated.
